Viewing Weekly Freight Payment Run Data

To view weekly freight payment data, click the "Carrier Invoice" icon

 at the top of the screen.

If no report appears, click the report drop-down arrow and select the "Weekly Run Report".



The run date is changed every Monday to reflect the previous Thursday's run.

If you would like to view a run date other than the current one, use the following instructions:

- Click on the words **report format** on the left-hand side of your screen.
- Under the **filter** section will be the current run date: Ex. **Run Date = 5/6/2010**.
- Change the run date using the following format: **m/d/yyyy**. Run dates are generally Thursday's.

Details of individual carrier invoices can be obtained by clicking the paper

icon  to the left of the shipment.

Weekly run data can be downloaded into a CSV or Excel format. Click the green Microsoft Excel icon or the white CSV icon at the top of the screen.



These icons are next to the drop-down arrow that enabled you to choose the "Weekly Run Report". Choose to open or save the file.

The TMS Report Writer can be used to create reports for virtually any freight bill data. USTC can teach your company how to use the report writer to create ad hoc reports or we can create and schedule reports for your company.

TMS Tips and Tricks

- ☞ Only the state abbreviation (ex. MD) can be used when creating a bill of lading. If you use the entire state name (ex. Maryland), the returned rates **will not** be accurate.
- ☞ Certain notifications can be set up that alert you to the fact that changes have been made in the TMS. For example, if your customer creates a bill of lading in the system, the TMS can automatically send you an e-mail notification.
- ☞ In Shipment and Carrier Invoice details, double-clicking the light gray area will hide the section details (example below; details are shown closed in the first customer rates area and open in the second customer rates area). This cleans up your screen and makes viewing shipment or invoice details easier.

STRAWBERRY DAIQUIRI DESSERT

- 2 cup strawberries, hulled
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1/3 cup dark rum
- 1/4 cup lime juice
- 1-1/2 cups sorbet (any flavor; some delicious choices are - mango, coconut, banana, strawberry)
- Lime zest as garnish

DIRECTIONS

1. For daiquiri mixture, in a blender container combine strawberries, powdered sugar, rum and lime juice. Cover and blend until smooth.
2. Divide the sorbet among 6 dessert dishes. Pour the daiquiri mixture around the sorbet, and then garnish each serving with a lime zest. Makes 6 servings.
